

Bay View Lutheran Church Covid Guidelines

(effective 1/14/2022)

WORSHIP SERVICES (8am, 10:30am, funerals)

- MASKING and SOCIAL DISTANCING are REQUIRED upon entering the church building.
 - Please wear a properly fitting mask that covers your nose and mouth.
 - Please have your mask on when you enter the church building.
- Those leading the church service (Pastor Jeff and readers) may choose to remove their mask when speaking from the chancel area. Pastor Jeff will wear his mask during the children's sermon and during communion, as would the communion assistants.
- Congregational singing will be temporarily suspended (at least through January 2022). Piano music will be provided at the 8am service. Praise Band will wear masks and continue to play and sing at the 10:30 service.
- Every other pew will be open for seating as marked by a flower. Please sit with family members or close contacts. Singles may sit at opposite ends of open pews.
- For Communion, please come to the front keeping your mask on until you receive the host. After drinking the wine, please put your mask back on as you return to your seat. Also please maintain a reasonable distance between you and those you are not sitting with.
- The 10:30am worship service will be held in conjunction with Facebook Live.
- The worship service is also available on YouTube on Monday mornings.
- These guidelines will also be in place for funerals.

ACTIVITIES and MEETINGS

- MASKING and SOCIAL DISTANCING are REQUIRED at all times when in the church building at least through January 2022.
- For everyone's safety, please be mindful of your personal space and the personal space of others. Recommended distance between you and those not in your family or close contacts is six feet.
- No sharing of food or beverages at this time. The kitchen is closed.
- Staff may remove their masks when working alone in their office.
