QUESTION AND ANSWER ABOUT COVID

Transmission: How is the coronavirus transmitted?

Evidence suggests that COVID spreads mainly from person to person, primarily through respiratory droplets that are released when a person sneezes, coughs, or talks. These droplets are propelled through the air and can land in the noses and mouths of people, especially those in close proximity (six feet or less), according to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and World Health Organization (WHO). Research supported by the CDC also suggests that COVID may spread through aerosol, or airborne, transmission. This is similar to transmission by droplets except that the amounts of fluid are much smaller and can linger in the air for a much longer time and infect people further than six feet away.

How long does the coronavirus live on surfaces?

The virus can live from several hours to several days on surfaces, depending on the type of material (cardboard, plastic, etc.). Even so, **the CDC says that COVID is not transmitted easily through surfaces and spreads mainly from person-to-person.** If you are concerned about surface contamination, you can find details on appropriate cleaning and sanitizing protocols from the CDC.*

We are blessed to have vaccines that will keep us from getting the virus, and from giving it to others. To achieve "herd immunity", as many people as possible need to get vaccinated. People are considered fully vaccinated 7-10 days following their second shot, or 2 weeks following the J&J single shot. You are then free to meet normally with other fully vaccinated people, go shopping, etc. You should still wear a mask out in public at this time. We are coming to the end of a long, isolated time. Let's all work together, get vaccinated, and then we can be together again!
